




## QUICKNUBE INSTALLATION GUIDE

1. Create a folder on the server where you will install Quicknube (We suggest that you call it "quicknube").




2. Download and open the file "quicknube.zip" which contains the Quicknube files.

3. Connect to the database management page of your server. (We recommend "MySQL" and "PhpMyAdmin").




4. Import into the database the file "install/dbtables.sql" in the "quicknube.zip" file that you previously downloaded.



5. Copy the files in the "quicknube.zip" file inside the folder initially created on the server.


6. Open the file "includes/php/constants.php" on your server with a text editor and edit the following lines:
  - 8 to line 11, enter in the field "DB\_SERVER" the information to connect to the server database, in the fields "DB\_USER" and "DB\_PASS", the username and password to log on to the database and in the field "DB\_NAME" the name of the database created earlier.



- 64 to line 66, enter information for sending mail service: enter in the field "EMAIL\_FROM\_NAME" the name that will be displayed by the mail recipients, in the field

"EMAIL\_FROM\_ADDR" your email address (specially created) to send the mail of Quicknube service.

- 79, enter in the field "TOT\_SPACE" the total size (in gb) of space that you want to dedicate to Quicknube. For example, if your hosting gives you 20 GB, and want to dedicate entirely to Quicknube, enter the number 20.

- 85, enter in the field "USER\_SPACE" the total space allocated to each user (in GB), if users need 3 GB each, enter 3.
- 93, enter in the field "SYSTEM\_LICENSE" the license (not required) of your Quicknube system. For more information contact support.
- 99, in the case had been changed, enter the name of the folder where you installed Quicknube, being careful to precede the name with a Slash. If the folder is called "quicknube" leave the field with the default string "/quicknube".
- It is possible to make additional changes to the default settings of Quicknube looking at the comments on the page "constants.php" or asking for assistance.

The Quicknube system is now correctly installed.
